

PRE-EVENT

- **01** Identify waste streams
- 02 Select sorting bins
- 03 Map venue & existing points
- O4 Create signage and procure supplies
- 05 Train chefs and staff
- O6 Pre-set bins and support chefs' preparation before event date

DURING EVENT

- 01 Set up bins
- **02** Monitor sorting stations
- O3 Change/ provide more clean bins for stations
- **04** Segregate Waste strictly
- 05 Cooperate with stewarding team

POST-EVENT

- 01 Collect all leftovers
- O2 Clean-up and haul resources to end-site
- 03 Measure and records
- O4 Treat waste and make poultry feed
- 05 Feedbacks and communications for achievements

- Monitor and collect full waste containers

Main Actions After the Event



Upcycle organic waste into animal feed & promote animal welfare

- Method 1: Grind and mix collected organic waste with other ingredients to make animal feed
- Method 2: Directly feed Black Soldier Fly (BSF) Larvae with organic waste
- Then, produced feed or BSF will feed cage-free chickens at our farm
- Finally, these chickens will produce nutritious humane eggs

Rich nutrients, high protein foods: 50% Protein, 35% fat, 6% Ca, 1.2% P, 1% Mg, 0.3% Na
Resistance to pathogens and harmful microorganisms: consume and digest
microorganisms, producing antibacterial and/or fungal compounds.
